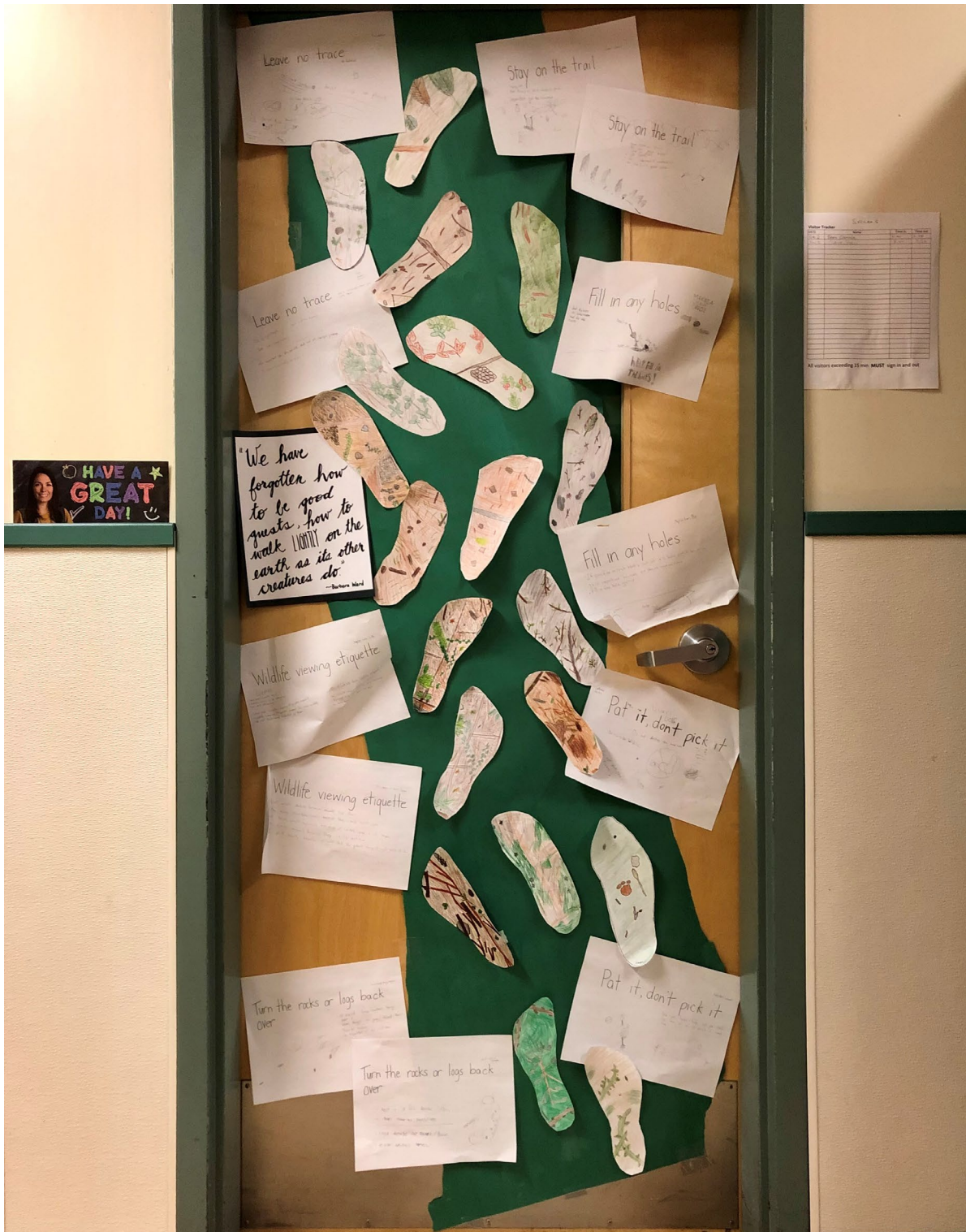


## Environment Education at McKim
