Drop Off Bin at Front Door

To keep our students and staff safe, we have a drop off bin at the front door for items your kids might need during the day. Simply put your child's name on the item, leave it in the box and our office staff will come and pick it up and deliver it to your child.

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Communication at McKim During COVID

Communication between school and home has been more challenging with COVID restrictions, but it is our goal to keep our families fully informed and engaged in the learning experiences that your child is involved with at McKim. We look forward to the time when we can have parents in the building on a more regular basis. In the meantime, it is our goal to empower our classroom teams (teacher and education assistant) as these staff have strong relationships with students. Parents are encouraged to be active participants in the communication process by emailing your child's classroom teacher or writing in your child's planner.

Each classroom team has a unique classroom culture and uses a variety of methods to communicate with parents. These include a combination of the following:

- Planner
- Email
- Portal or class website
- Text messaging
- Phone call
- Virtual meeting (via Teams)

You can expect general communication from your child's teacher regarding regular activities in the classroom, trips to the Nature Park, or special activities such as a movie. More personal communication may come from the classroom team for incomplete work, challenging behaviors, or instances when a student in unprepared for a field trip. Our learning services and office team may also contact parents to support students with learning or behavior needs.
